

COMPETITION ANNOUNCEMENT FOR SANT'EFISIO COLLEGE UNIVERSITY ADMISSION Academic year 2023/2024

Monsignor Paolo Botto Foundation

The Monsignor Paolo Botto foundation is a body of private law, member of the University College of Merit Conference (CCUM) acknowledged and accredited by the Ministry of Education, University and Research (MUR), that manages the Sant'Ef시오 University College of Cagliari. The Sant'Ef시오 University College of Cagliari is a residential structure, with an elevated cultural and formative qualification, that pursues the enhancement of merits and the interculturality of preparation, providing each student, on the basis of a personalized project, educational, tutoring and orientation services. For the academic year 2023 - 2024 the Mons. Paolo Botto Foundation announces a competition for the students' admission to the University College Sant'Ef시오. The intended period of stay is from September 1 2023 to July 31 2024.

Purpose

The assigned positions at Sant'Ef시오 University College are destined to students who are strongly motivated in achieving excellent academic scores and the complete acquisition of "soft skills", qualifying elements for acknowledgement as a college of merit. To this end students will : - Participate in the training agreement proposed for the development of these competences. - Participate in activities and courses organized by CUSE, held by University professors or exponents of professions or companies, with an attendance of 50 hours per student every academic year for the first three years of University and of 15 hours for the following. - achieve an academic performance in line with ministerial requests for colleges of merit ; - Valorise relationship and community aspects of the College life (common space management, small group meetings, assignments) as soft skills development opportunities. Concretely the personalized formative project includes the participation in non-formal and informal activities ,integrative to the University studies.

Services offered by the Sant'Efisio University College

The admission to the Sant'Efisio University College gives students the right to benefit from quality accommodation and a personalized formative path.

a. Housing offer

<u>Accommodation</u>	Single room with bathroom
<u>Utilities</u>	Water, electricity, heating system and air conditioning
<u>Canteen Service</u>	Breakfast, 8 meals/month for lunch or dinner in the internal cafeteria with choice of menù , accessible every day except for saturday dinners or sunday morning breakfast.
<u>Kitchen</u>	Kitchen equipped for cooking and tables for eating
<u>Wi-Fi</u>	Free Wi-Fi in all the building
<u>Laundry</u>	Coin-operated washing machine
<u>Cleaning</u>	Daily cleaning services of common spaces and thorough monthly room cleaning if requested..
<u>Common spaces</u>	Access to study room, classrooms, meeting rooms
<u>Leisure spaces</u>	Access to common room, Tv room, park and various spaces for relaxing
<u>Chapel</u>	Chapel dedicated to prayer and gathering..
<u>Garden</u>	Green area around the building and internal cloister.
<u>Parking</u>	Reserved internal parking area.
<u>Video Surveillance</u>	Video Surveillance system of shared spaces and external areas.
<u>Maintenance</u>	Ordinary and extraordinary maintenance service.

The personalized formative path is developed throughout continuous dialogue, that starts with the tutoring in the first year of university and proceeds to support competence and potential development, as requested by the Ministry for the colleges of merit.



b. Personalized formative path

Personalized training course agreed with College management
 Targeted activities of educational tutoring;
 Activities of individual coaching with psychological and planning preparation for university career, performed by highly qualified specialists
 Work and career service related orientation activities.
 Soft skills development, throughout workshops, cultural visits , seminars and conferences , musical events and theatre workshops;
 Recreational activities including filmclub , parties, planned trips and group sports.

Admission Requisites

Students who have enrolled during the academic year 2023-2024, in any degree year (Master's degree, bachelor) of the University of Cagliari, The Pontifical Theological Faculty of Sardinia, State Music Conservatory of Cagliari or any other equalized entities of university studies present in the city, can request admission to the college and also : -

- a) Students who enroll in the academic year 2023-2024 must have passed their High School Diploma with a minimum score of 70/100.
- b) b) Students who enroll one year later of academic year 2023-2024 , must have an academic score not below 24/30 or an equivalent degree score for those who enroll to the Master Degree.
- c) Must not be 24 years old on the date of request presentation. Must not be criminally convicted or have pending charges.

The requests of those who do not fit requisites sub a/b/c will be taken in consideration only in the case of residual positions. During the selection process particular attention will be given to the formation of a student community of international scope. You will have to provide this documentation at the admission examination office : - For those who enroll in the academic year 2023-2024 : Copy of High School Diploma with scoring. If the Diploma is not yet in student's possession, a vouched self-certification of having passed the Diploma examination with scoring is necessary, while awaiting a copy of the official document; also last year report page scoring.

- For those who in the academic year 2023-2024 enroll a year after the first one : a vouched self-certification of the exams taken and their



dates, scoring and CFU number reachable at the personal area Cineteca Esse3 ;

- For those who are already in possession of a Bachelor Degree and enroll in academic year 2023-2024 for Master's Degree : vouched self-certification of Degree achievement with scoring.

All students must also attach :

- ISEE certification of family income for university education starting from January 2023
- Last year High School test scores (report card)
- Self-certification of not being criminally convicted
- Badge shaped photo
- -Written self-introduction based on the outline of the participation request.
- short self introduction video in which the candidate says their name, surname, age, place of origin and school attended.

If one of the documents requested is not presented it could compromise the admission to the competition.

Process of admission and announcement expiry

The process of admission is articulated as follows:

1. Send request (based on the set of forms made available) to email addresses : direzione@collegesantefisio.it; fondazionebotto@pec.it
2. College admission test
3. Reception of exam result , and if positive, confirmation of position by student
4. Signing of the contract in College and acceptance of educational pact and internal regulations, with simultaneous payment of first instalment of tuition fee and deposit based on article 7. The first instalment will not be refunded in case of subsequent renunciation to enrollment.

Two sessions are provided for the admission exam :**21/07/2023 and 15/09/2023** (second date provided only in case of residual positions).

The admission request (Point A) must be received by 17/07/2023 for the July session, and by 11/09/2023 for the September session.



Admission test

The admission test consists of a questionnaire and consecutive individual interviews , finalised in evaluating the study curriculum and examining in depth personal projects, interests, motivations, extra formative and relational capacities. The exam will be evaluated by University College Sant'Efisio's Management , with a maximum score of 100 points : maximum 25 points for the curriculum and 75 for interview and questionnaire. The decision of the Management is incontestable. Before the exam the candidate must read the formative pact and internal regulations.

Tuition and groups of distribution

For all the services listed in article 2 the yearly tuition of Sant'Efisio college A.A 2023/24 is formed by 11 monthly payments, from September 2023 to July 2024, for a total of 6.820,00€. The students' contribution to the cost is calculated on the base of the ISEE certification of family income for university education starting from January 2023 ; the remaining part shall be borne by the Monsignor Paolo Botto Foundation.

In the maximum contribution band (VI band) will be automatically placed.

- the students who declare on the request to make use of the option of not submitting the ISEE certification of family income for university education starting from January 2023;
- The students who , even though have asked to be inserted in one of the six contribution bands , have submitted a ISEE certification with discrepancies/omissions or not valid; This table below includes the contribution borne by students on the tuition fee determined by the College for A.A 2023/2024 :

The contribution borne by students will be divided in 11 instalments to be paid monthly. If the student decides to make use of thorough monthly room cleaning, the yearly tuition will increase to €220,00 , with an increase of the monthly instalment of €20,00. Along with the first month rent it is requested the deposit payment of 2 month's rent , calculated based on the contribution band the student is part of . This deposit will be refunded at the end of your stay at the Sant'Efisia College , except for the case of any damage detected during the check- out. The contributions qualify as a tuition fee reduction and do not provide for a disbursement of money in favour of the student.

Merit bonus

As a result of the outcome of half-yearly meetings , and on the base of submitted academic certifications, The Monsignor Paolo Botto Foundation, in our sole discretion , will issue an additional bonus in reduction of monthly tuition fee for study merits.

The reduction, will be assigned to those who meet the following requirements.

- weighted average of exam scores above or equal to 28/30 ;
- 75% +1 of training credits estimated according to the students' study plan.
- - stay up-to-date with the study plan.
- The academic situation must be declared at the end of the exam session (february and july), throughout the submission of the University of Cagliari's certification on the student web-portal. The students who have enrolled to the Pontificia Facoltà Teologica, Conservatorio Statale di Musica or other courses of study must submit a self certification of weighted average according to DPR 445/2000 . Declarations unsubstantiated by certifications will not be taken into consideration. The reduction will be applied to the months of October, November, December, January, February for the first semester ; March , April, May,June, July for the second semester.

The Merit Bonus will be guaranteed for students from Band II to IV : the students in Band II will have a reduction on the monthly instalment of €410,00 and €380,00, the students from band III to IV will have a reduction of 10% on the monthly instalment .



The students in Band I cannot access the Merit Bonus. For the students who enroll in the first year of their course, reduction will be taken in consideration starting from the results of the second exam session period.

Tuition reduction for nuclear family

A tuition reduction will be applied to all students with simultaneous compresence of other family members in the college (brothers/sisters). In this case the tuition will be reduced by a monthly 10% per collegiate. Students in Band I will not be able to access to the tuition reduction for nuclear family.

The reductions for nuclear family and bonus for academic merit cannot be combined.

Contract renewal after the first year

The acceptance into the college will be renewed yearly at the incontestable discretion of Management, on the basis of academic performance and the percentage of CFU obtained during the previous academic year, and of the participation to the proposed formative path. The contract for the following year will be stipulated by june.
